Weekly Report 3/25/19 - 3/31/19

One main focus during the week was planning for the developmental stages of the final product. During the week, key questions were developed for the next mentor visit. These questions mainly focused on how the CORA method could be used in general practice. From those questions stemmed the final idea for the physical product. Through discussion with Dr. Radasch, the question about how to make the final product as impactful as possible was a large focus of the week. It was decided that creating an online database and hardcopy how-to would be the most effective way to spread the information.

Planning for the final product development will include creating a second website that will be completely dedicated to the awareness program. In the database it will include a written explanation of implementing the CORA method, step-by-step picture guide to planning for a singular plane deformity, and a video guide to planning for a singular plane deformity. The second stage of the awareness program will be to provide hard copy of the online database for local veterinarians. In addition, referral options will be provided in the hardcopy, such as, radiologist to provide the CT Scan, and surgeons.
