This week, the first mentor visit was conducted, while it was only for the handbook, it was still very informative. A major focal point was over the final product and what it really is. During the discussion, he explained how seldom they have hip dysplasia cases they operate on, due to late diagnosis, and thus hip dysplasia would be a difficult option to investigate further. This had no raised questions as to what the final product will be over, further research will need to be made. Once that research is conducted, questions for the staff regarding the research will be a clear indicator of the necessity for the research topic.

The second focal point of discussion was how the mentor visits would work. He explained how all staff members are open to letting me view their surgeries, allowing for more observations and thus more knowledge.
